Please send the abstract as an attachment to azu@ukzn.ac.za in doc or "docx" format. The scientific committee will evaluate the abstract. If approved, only 1 poster presentations will be allowed.

Instructions to prepare the abstract:

- The theme of the abstract should be on Plastination, Anatomy and all related clinically applied areas.
- Should be written in English
- The title should be in capital letters followed by the names of the authors, department affiliation, and name of the institution, city and country.
- The name of the presenter should be underlined.
- The abstract should contain Introduction, Objectives, Methods, Results and Conclusions.
- Should be typed in Times New Roman, font size 12 in single space.
- Maximum number of characters should not exceed 3200 including spaces.
